IF Cover Installation Guide



The IF cover is useful for protecting and organizing cables and for maintaining a clear workplace or office environment.


Refer to the following procedures for installing the IF cover onto the rear of the printer.

Connecting the cables before installing the IF cover will make the process simpler.

Only the IF cover and this manual are included. If the IF cover is damaged, please contact the retailer.

Installing the IF Cover

1. Insert the square bosses on the left and right of the IF cover into the square holes on the left and right of the lower case. Push until they click into place. [See Fig. 1]



Wiring the Cables

2. There is an outlet on both sides of the cover for the cables to pass through. Please use which ever side is most convenient based on your printer setup. [See Fig. 2]

Removing the IF Cover from the Printer

3. While pushing the left and right sides of the IF cover inwards (at the circular points in the illustration), pull the cover in the direction indicated by the arrow to release the lock and allow easy removal of the cover. [See Fig. 3]
