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1. Software Overview

Star Windows Software package contains the Star Windows Driver and a printer utility. To use the software package, follow the procedure given in [“3. Installation”](#) and then turn the printer on.

The mode setting status can be checked from [Operation Mode] in the list that is printed at printer test printing. (For the test printing, turn power ON while holding down the FEED button.)

When using in a different mode, please contact the reseller that sold you the printer.

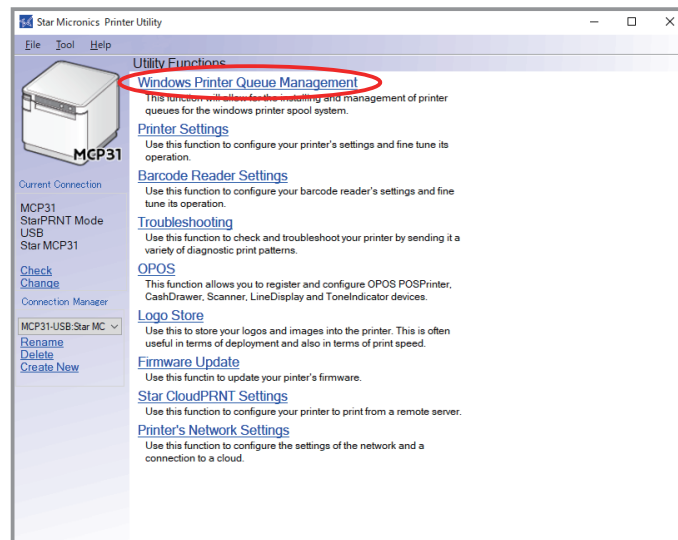
1.1 Star Windows Driver

The Star Windows Driver is used when files are printed from Windows applications.

Install the Star Windows Software, and then connect a printer with a USB interface to the PC. The Plug and Play feature will enable the Star Windows Driver automatically.

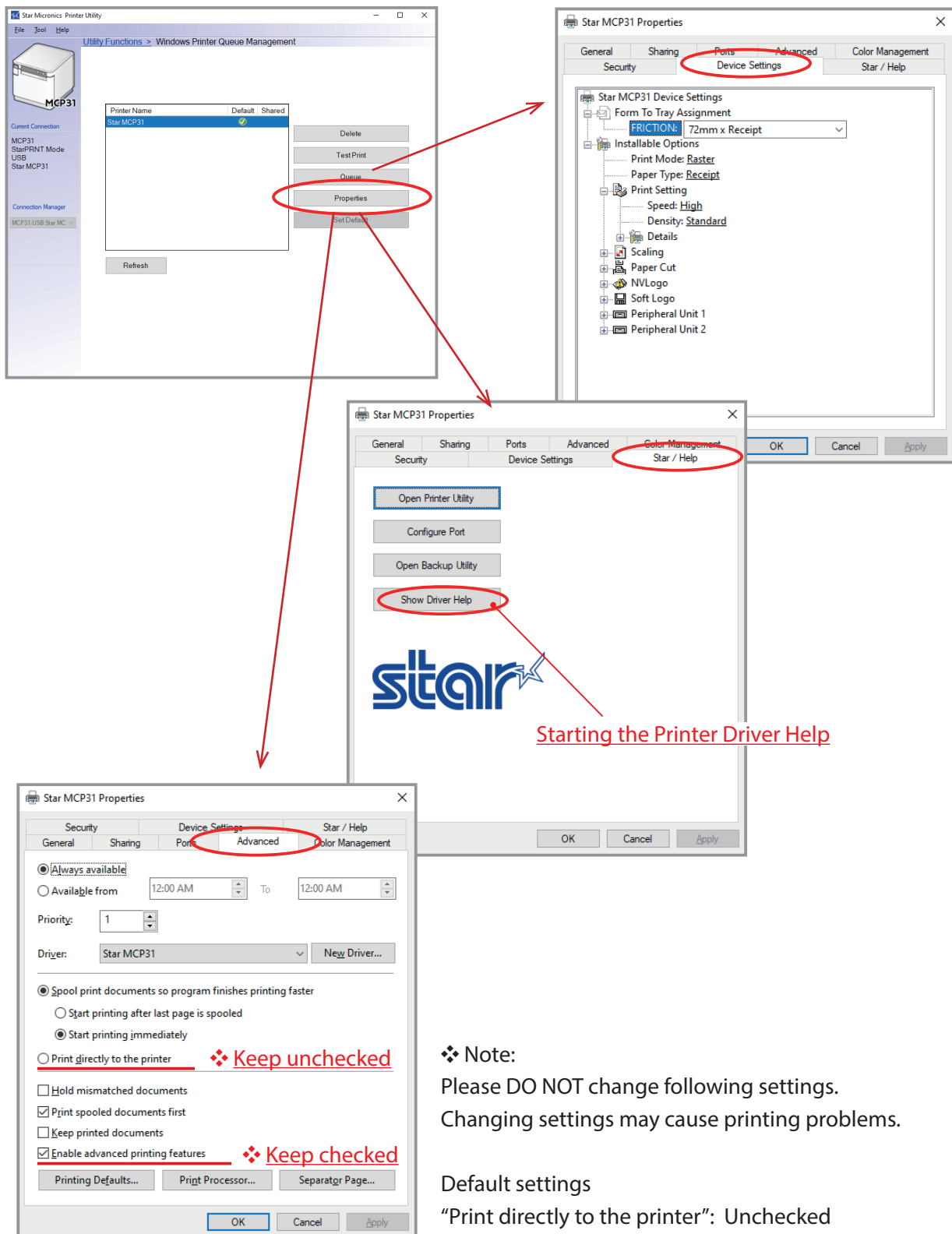
To use the Star Windows Driver when you are connecting to the printer through an interface other than USB, install the driver from the Windows Printer Queue Management window of the printer utility.

Note: If you cannot print after changing the Printer Queue Name, please try restarting the PC.



When using the printer through the Star Windows Driver, you can set options such as the paper type, paper cut type, and logo print method by clicking Properties in the Windows Printer Queue Management window of the printer utility.

For details about the printer driver, see the printer driver help.



1.2 Printer Utility

The printer utility is used to connect to the printer and to set various options.

It can be used in conjunction with the Star Windows Driver, OPOS driver, and in numerous other environments.

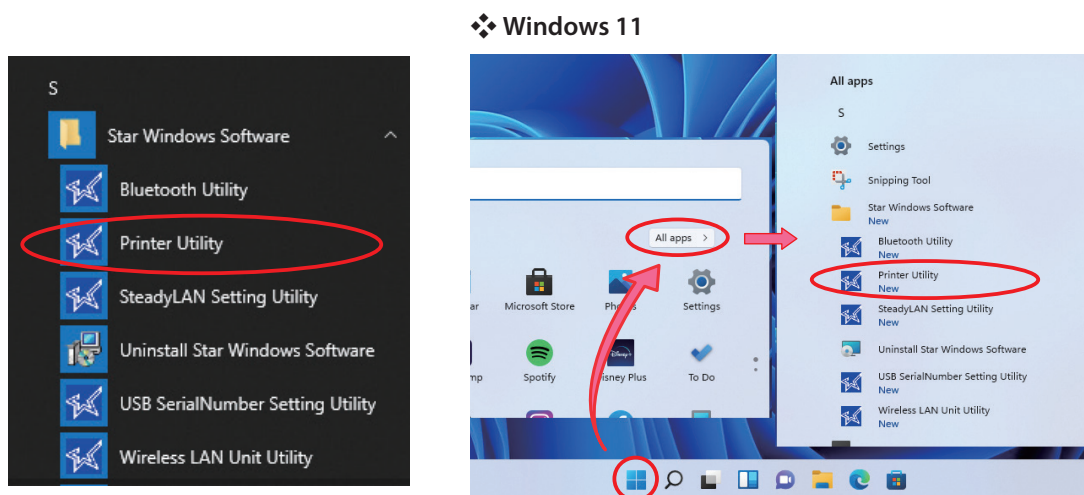
The printer utility is used over a specific "Connection" ("Connection" has specific properties the connection method).

For details on how to configure connections and on the utility functions, see the printer utility help.

1.2.1 Starting the Printer Utility

- ① On the Windows taskbar, click 'Start', and then click 'Star Windows Software' > 'Printer Utility'.

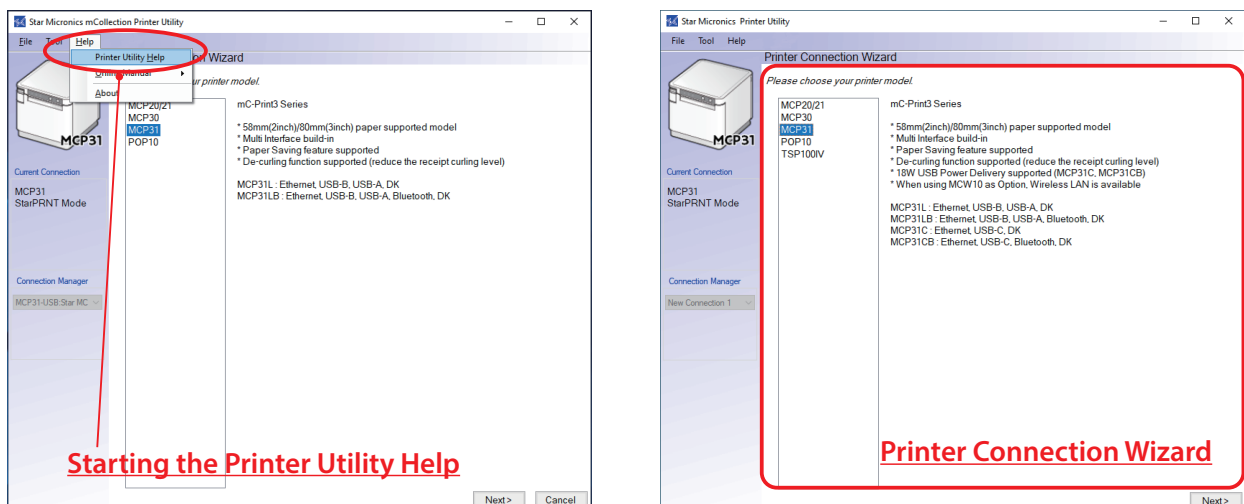
*Windows11: On the Windows taskbar, click 'Start', and then click > 'All apps' > 'Star Windows Software' > 'Printer Utility'.



- ② The 'User Account Control' dialog appears. Click 'Yes'.

- ③ The printer utility window opens.

When you start the printer utility for the first time, the 'Printer Connection Wizard' appears. Please choose the interface to create a connection. You will be able to use the printer utility functions through the connection that you created.

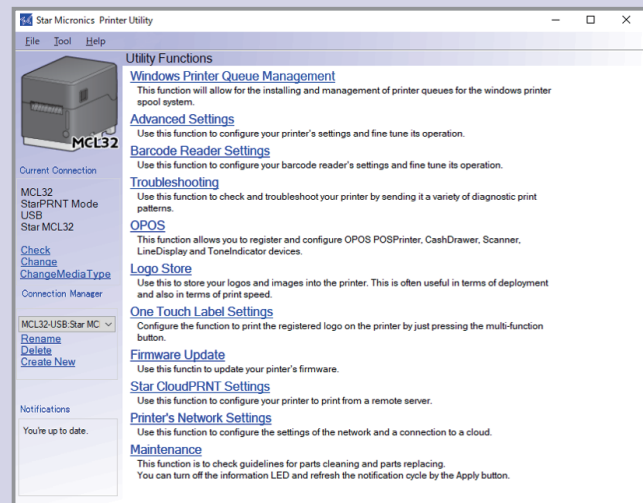


1.2.2 Printer Utility Functions

■ Utility Functions

Click a link in the list of utility functions to display the properties of the corresponding function.

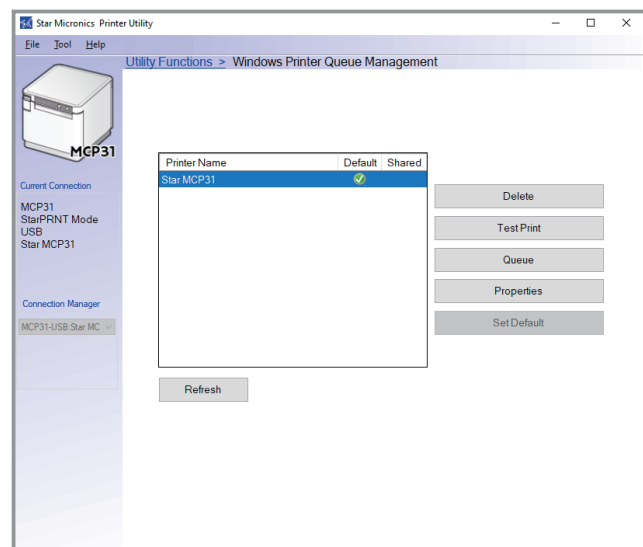
The printer utility is used over a specific connection (each connection has specific properties such as the connection method).



◆ Windows Printer Queue Management

Windows Printer Queue Management can be used to create and manage the printer queues of the Windows print spooler system.

To use the printer driver when you are connecting to the printer through an interface other than USB, install the Star Windows Driver from this function.

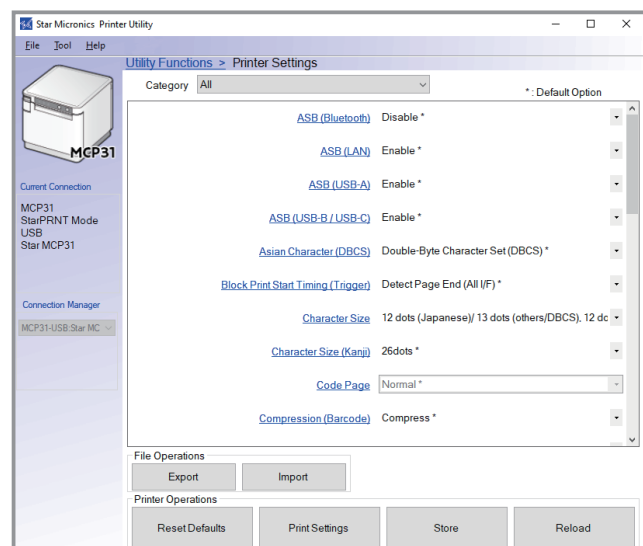


◆ Printer Settings

You can change the printer settings (memory switch settings) according to your needs.

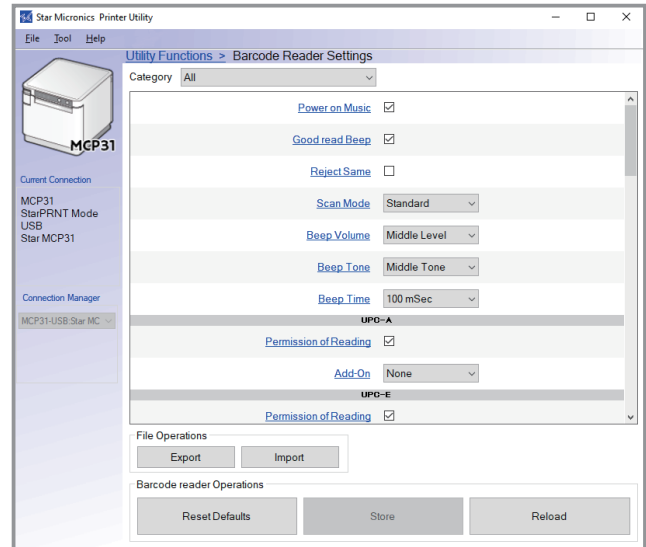
What are memory switches ?

You can configure the basic settings of a printer and store them in memory switches on the printer.



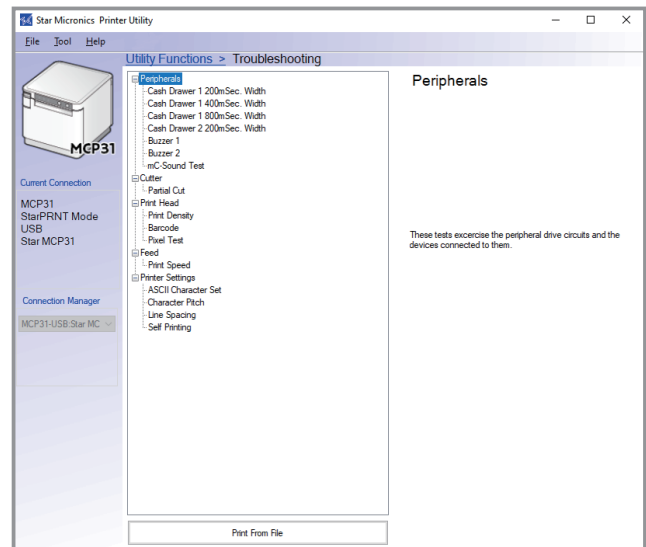
◆ Barcode Reader Settings

You can change the barcode reader settings according to your needs.
(MCP20 and MCP30 do not support.)



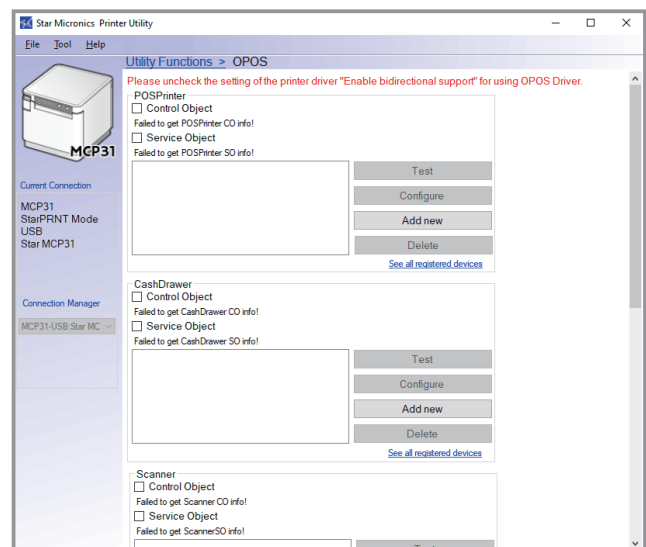
◆ Troubleshooting

You can check the operations of various printer functions.



◆ OPOS

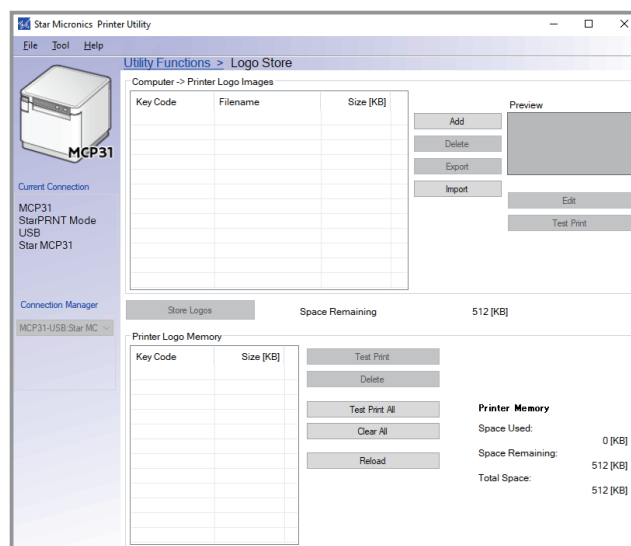
You can store, configure, and perform similar tasks for OPOS POS printer devices, cash drawer devices, scanner devices (Barcode Reader), line display device (Customer Display), and ToneIndicator (mC-Sound).



◆ Logo Store

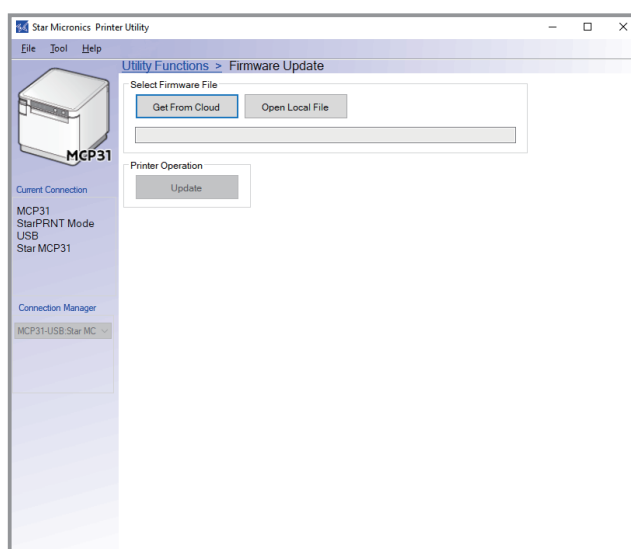
You can store logos (image data) in the printer's memory.

By storing logo and other image data that is printed frequently, you can expect increased print throughput, because there is no need to send the data every time you print.



◆ Firmware Update

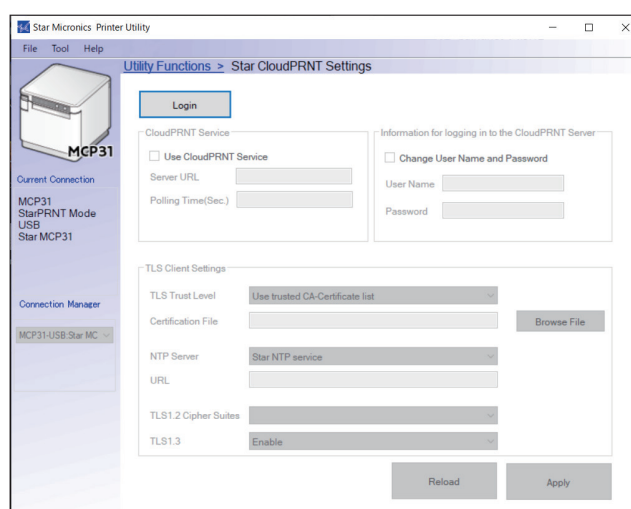
You can update your printer firmware via cloud or local file.



◆ Star CloudPRNT Settings

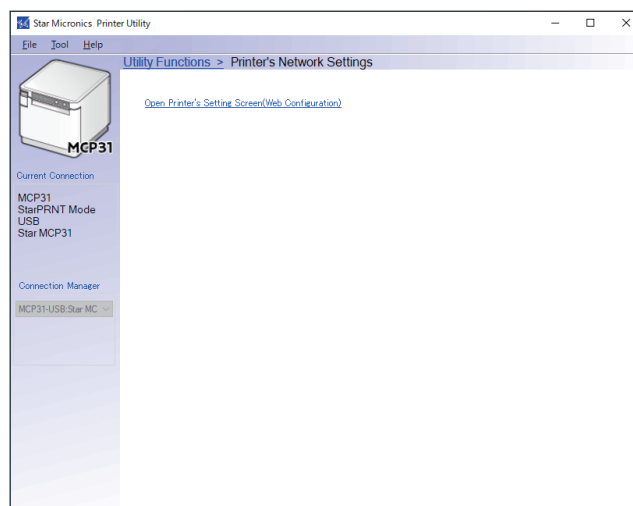
You can configure the settings to print from a remote server.

(mPOP and BSC10II do not support this feature.)



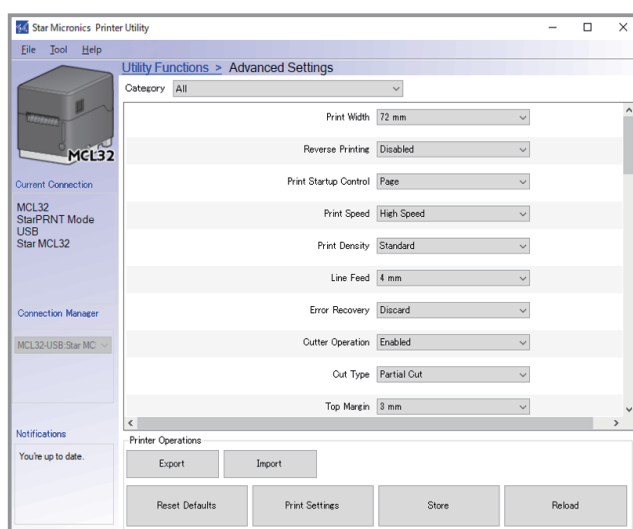
◆ Printer's Network Settings

Use this function to configure the settings of the network and a connection to a cloud.
(USB and Bluetooth interface are not supported.)



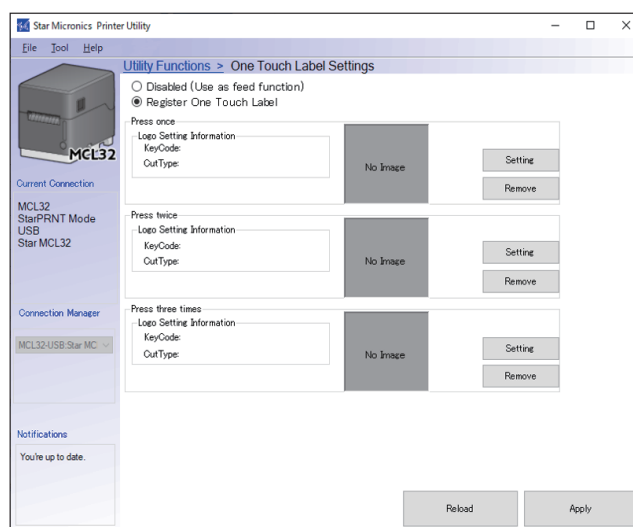
◆ Advanced Settings

Use this function to configure your printer's settings and fine tune its operation.



◆ One Touch Label Settings

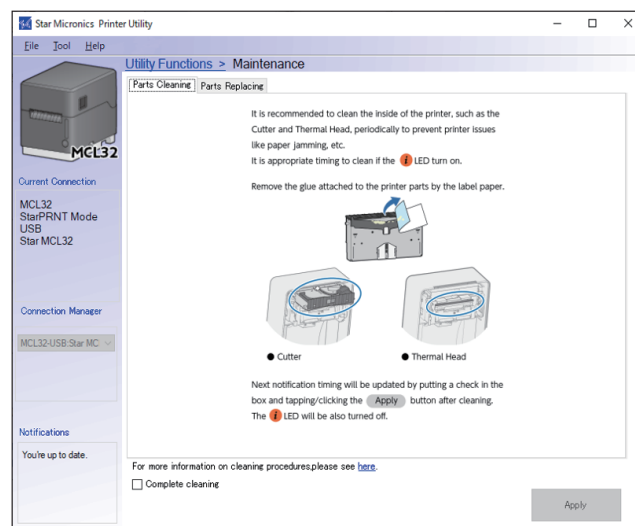
Configure the function to print the registered logo on the printer by just pressing the multi-function button.



◆ Maintenance

This function is to check guidelines for parts cleaning and parts replacing.

You can turn off the information LED and refresh the notification cycle by the Apply button.



2. Operating Environment

2.1 Operating System

This software supports the following operating systems.

- ◆ Microsoft Windows 11* 64-bit (except IoT Enterprise)
- ◆ Microsoft Windows 10* 32-bit and 64-bit (except IoT Enterprise)

*Limitation

- Printer using USB interface will not be appeared in [Device and Printer] if its power is off.

3. Installation

Important:

- Administrator privilege is required to run the installation.

Note: If you are connecting to the printer by USB, carry out the instructions in chapter 3, "Installation," and then turn the printer on.

Follow the instructions below to install the software.

- ① Download Software package file (<a> or) from Star's website*¹ and save it.

- ② When the saved file is <a>

Unzip the zip file, and execute "setup.exe" in the setup folder.

- ④ The 'User Account Control' dialog appears. Click 'Yes'.

❖ When futurePRNT is installed on your PC.

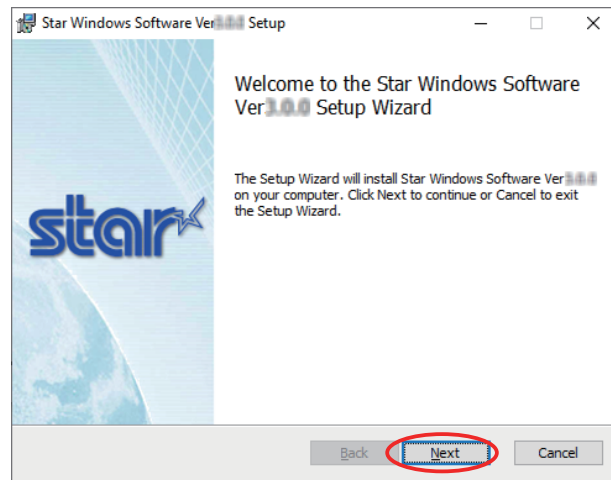
A confirmation dialog to uninstall futurePRNT is displayed.

Read the instructions of the dialog box, and then uninstall futurePRNT before installing this software.

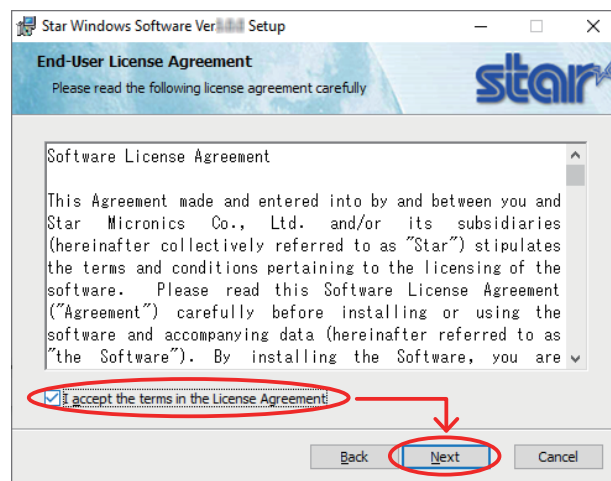
A part of the settings of futurePRNT can be transferred by using a transfer tool "Migration Assistant".

- ⑤ Click 'Next'.

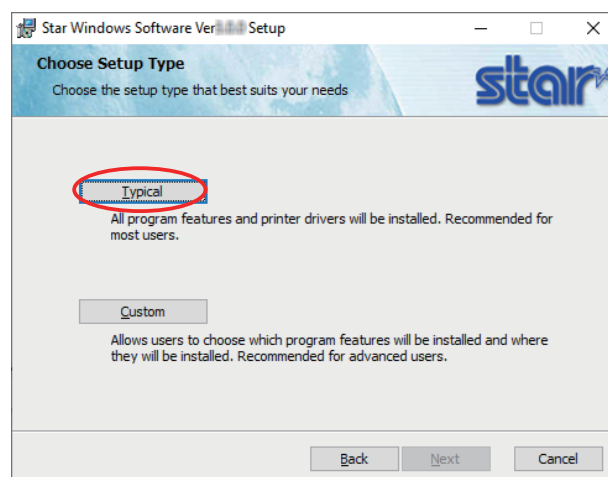


- ⑥ The End-User License Agreement, an agreement for installing the software, appears. Read the agreement. If you agree with the terms, select the 'I accept the terms in the License Agreement' check box, and then click 'Next'.

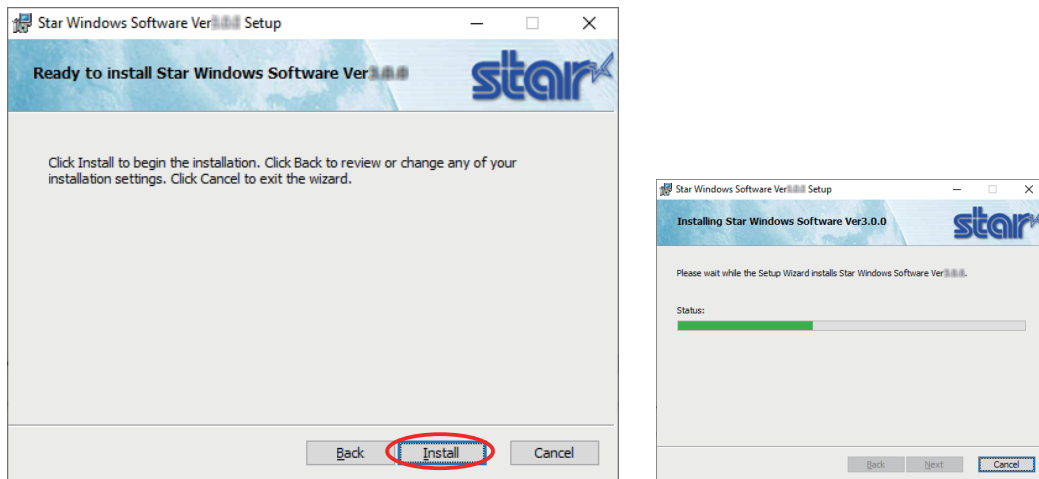


- ⑦ Choose the setup type.

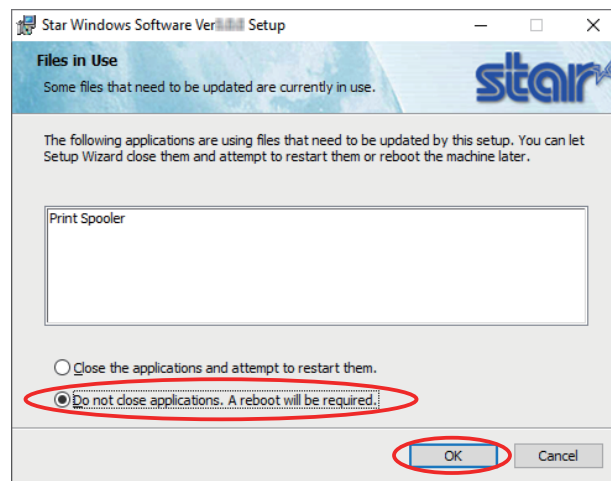
Click 'Typical' to install the all program features. Always select this option unless you have a specific reason. Click 'Custom' to install only the program features that you will need.



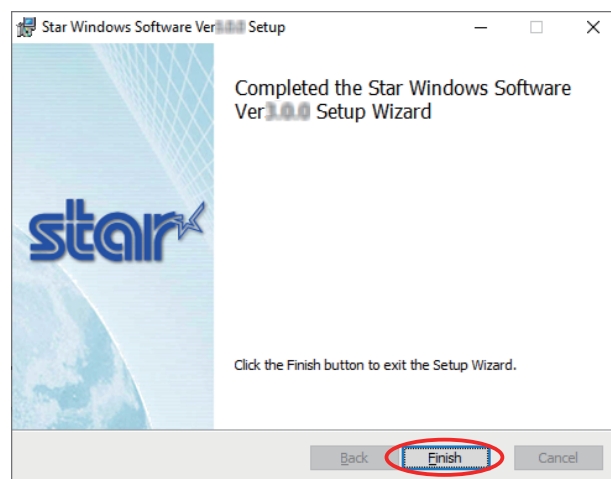
- ⑧ Click 'Install' to start the installation.



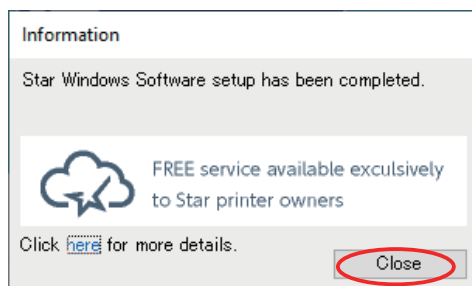
- ⑨ If the following confirmation dialog box appears, select the 'Do not close applications. A reboot will be required' option, and then click 'OK'.



- ⑩ When the software installation completes, the following window appears. Click 'Finish' to close the wizard.

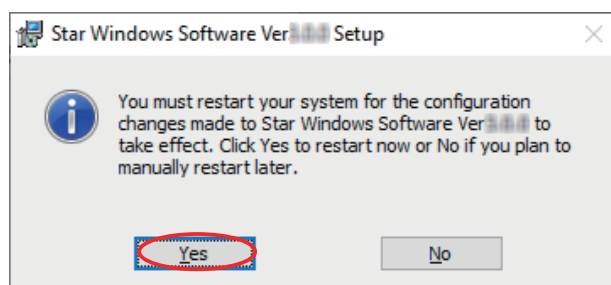


- ⑪ When the following dialog box is displayed, click the [Close] button.

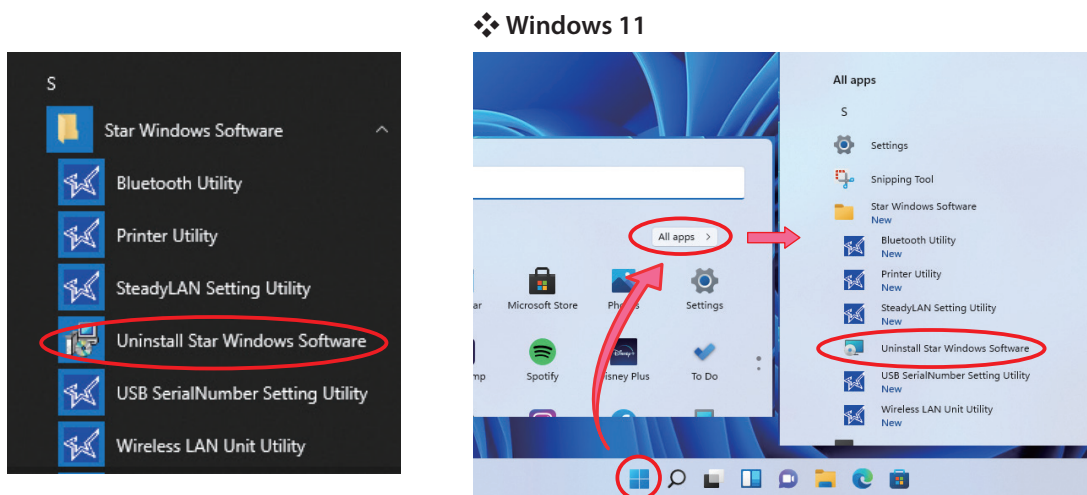
- ⑫ If the following confirmation window appears, click 'Yes'.



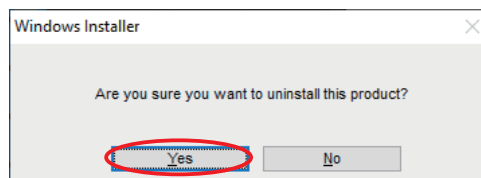
4. Uninstallation

Follow the procedure below to uninstall the software.

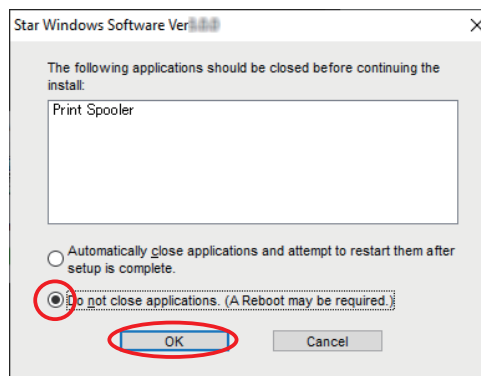
- ① Turn the printer power switch off.
- ② On the Windows taskbar, click 'Start', and then click 'Star Windows Software' > 'Uninstall Star Windows Software'.
- *Windows11: On the Windows taskbar, click 'Start', and then click > 'All apps' > 'Star Windows Software' > 'Uninstall Star Windows Software'.



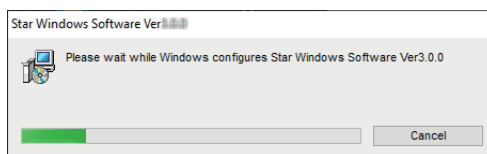
- ③ The 'User Account Control' dialog appears. Click or 'Yes'.
- ④ The following window appears. To continue, click 'Yes'.



- ⑤ If the following confirmation dialog box appears, select the 'Do not close applications' option, and then click 'OK'.



- ⑥ When the confirmation dialog box for restarting the system is displayed, click 'OK'.
- ⑦ The uninstallation program starts and removes all the relevant software components.

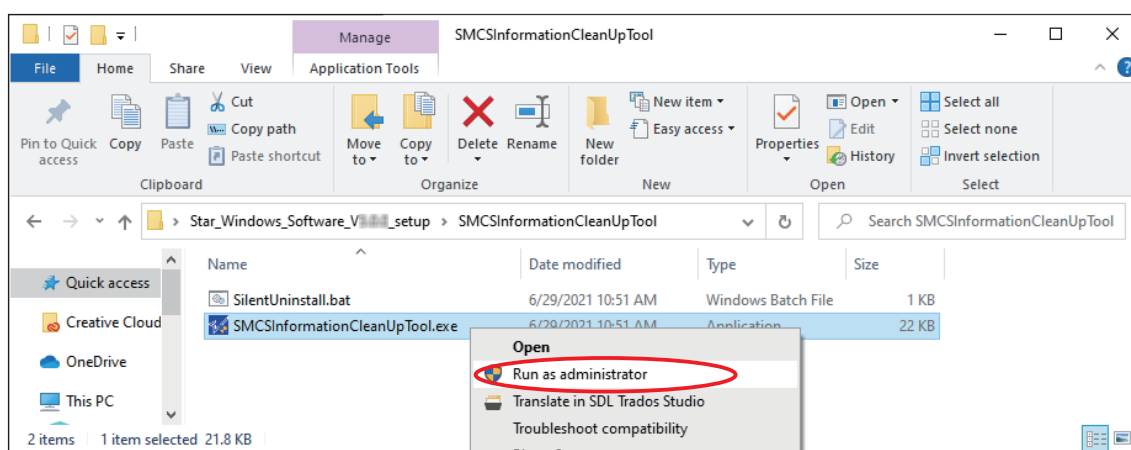


- ⑧ If you are using the Star Micronics Cloud Services, execute the following file.

- 1) Open the folder of the software package you downloaded for installation.
- 2) Run the files "SMCSInformationCleanUpTool.exe" in the folder path below as administrator.

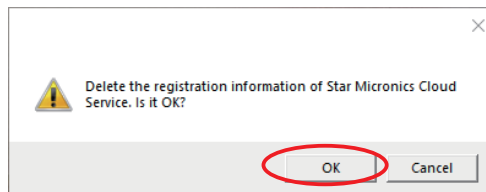

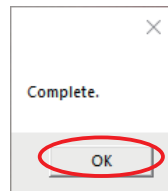
Unzip all files.

Execute "SMCSInformationCleanUpTool.exe" as Administrator.

- 4) The following window appears. To continue, click 'OK'.



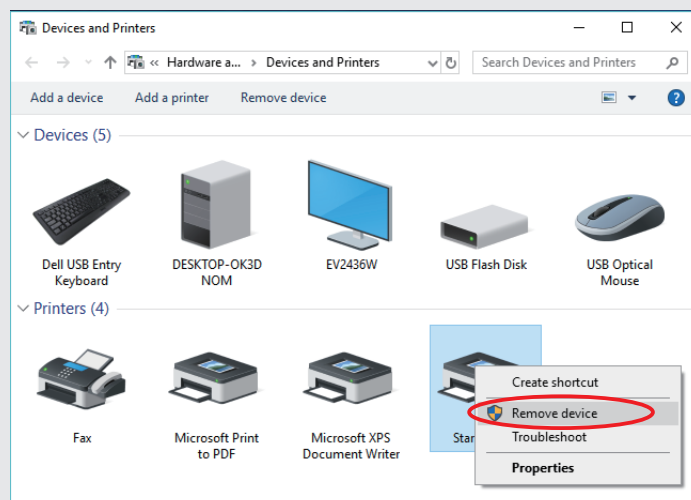
- 5) Click 'OK' to close the window.



❖ Note

After uninstalling the printer utility, the printer queue icon may remain in "Control Panel"->"Devices and Printers".

To delete it, right-click the printer queue icon and choose "Remove device" from the pull-down menu to delete it.



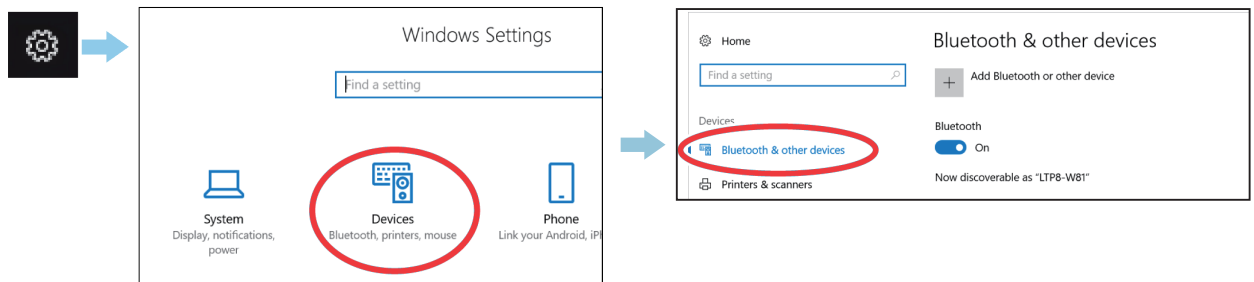

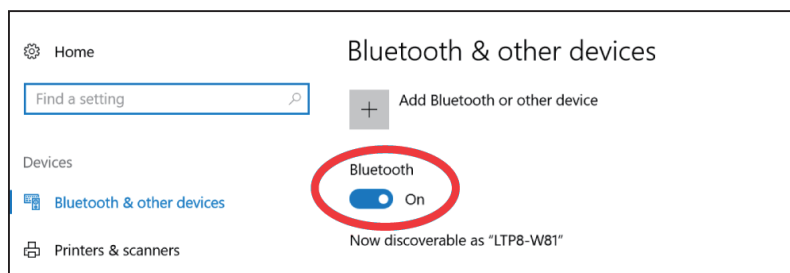
Appendix 1. Pairing with Bluetooth® in Windows

Follow the appropriate procedure.

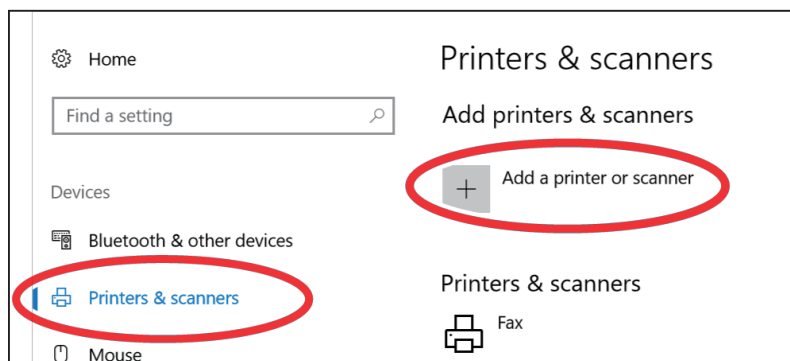
1. Windows10: Open [Settings], select [Devices] - [Bluetooth & other devices].
Windows11: Open [Settings], select [Bluetooth & devices].



2. Turn Bluetooth [On].



3. Select [Printers & scanners] - [Add a printer or scanner].



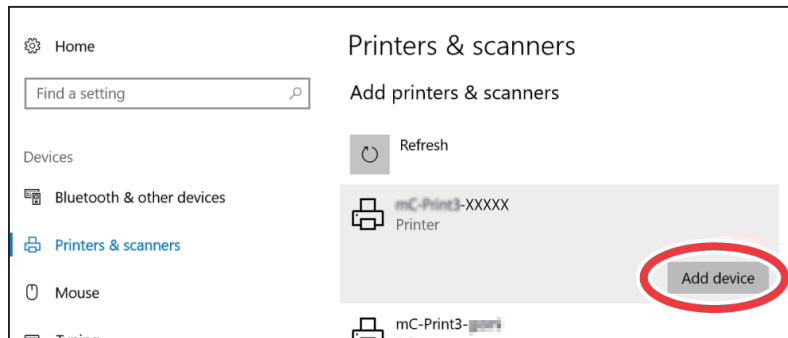
4. Select the Bluetooth device name, and click or tap [Add a device].

If the Bluetooth device name was changed, then select the device name that it was changed to.

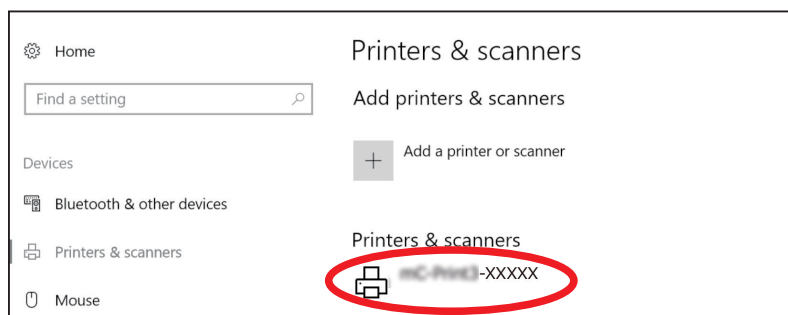
Checking the printer's Bluetooth address

The Bluetooth address is listed on the test print sheet.

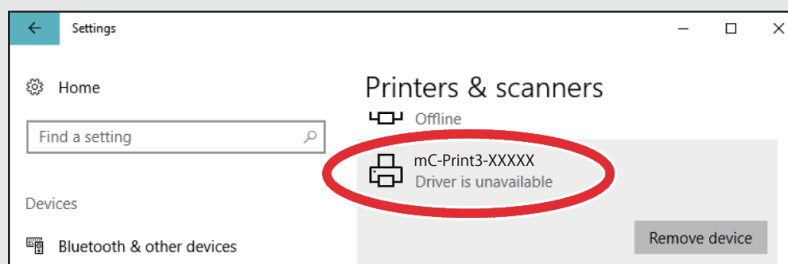
Please refer to the separate manual "Online Manual" for the test printing method.



5. When the device appears in "Printers & Scanners", pairing is completed.



After a while, "Driver is unavailable" will be displayed, however, pairing is completed.



The device name created here cannot be used for the destination specified when printing from a Windows application. Create a separate printer queue refer to ["♦ Windows Printer Queue Management"](#).
